A total of 1,440 new vehicles were sold in February 2016. New vehicles sales decreased by 9.1% from January 2016, and increased by 5% from a year ago. Additionally, 693 pre-owned vehicles were sold.

Ventura County Unemployment

The California Labor Market report revealed that Ventura County's February 2016 unemployment rate of 5.1% was down from a revised 5.3 in January 2016. A total of 3,800 non-farm jobs were added in February 2016, however; 600 jobs were lost, for a net increase of 3,200 jobs. The loss in jobs includes 600 in trade, transportation and utilities. The gain in jobs includes 1,200 in professional and business services, 800 in government, 700 in educational and health services, 500 in leisure and hospitality, 200 in construction, 100 in manufacturing, 100 in financial services, 100 in information, and 100 in other services.
