June 2016 Auto Sales Update

Local dealers sold a total of 1,538 new vehicles and 576 pre-owned vehicles in June 2016. New vehicle sales decreased by 2.04 percent from May 2016 and 0.73 percent from a year ago.

Ventura County Unemployment Update

The California Labor Market report revealed that Ventura County's June 2016 unemployment rate of 5.4 percent was up from a revised 4.5 percent in May 2016. A total of 1,700 non-farm jobs were added in June 2016 and 500 jobs were lost, for a net increase of 1,200 jobs. The loss in jobs includes 300 in trade, transportation and utilities, 100 in construction, and 100 in financial activities. The gain in jobs includes 700 in leisure and hospitality, 700 in professional and business services, 100 in government, 100 in educational and health services and 100 in manufacturing.
