## September 2016 Auto Sales Update

A total of 1,666 new vehicles and 669 pre-owned vehicles were sold in September 2016. New vehicle sales decreased 8.51 percent from August 2016, and dropped 8.21 percent from a year ago.

## County Unemployment Update

The California Labor Market report revealed that Ventura County's September 2016 unemployment rate of 5.5 percent was down from a revised 5.7 in August 2016. A total of 2,900 non-farm jobs were added in September. However 700 jobs were lost, for a net increase of 2,200 jobs. The loss in jobs includes 600 in leisure and hospitality and 100 in financial activities. The gain includes 2,000 in government, 400 in educational and health services, 300 in professional and business services, 100 in trade, transportation and utilities, and 100 in construction.
