City Council Appoints New Mayor & Mayor Pro Tem

On December 13 at our City's annual reorganization meeting, the City Council unanimously approved the appointment of Claudia Bill-de la Peña as Mayor and Andy P. Fox as Mayor Pro Tem. The event also honored outgoing Mayor Joel Price, who will remain active on the Council.



The five-member Council, which includes the recently re-elected Al Adam and Rob McCoy, nominates new leadership each year, selecting from among its members. The Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem serve a one-year term, taking effect immediately upon Council approval.
