## RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the appointment of Mark Kroenke to fill one unscheduled vacancy on the Investment Review Committee to serve the remainder of a two-year term ending July 2017.

## DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

As stated in the above reference agenda report, an Investment Review Committee member resigned mid-term, creating an unscheduled vacancy. The resignation was submitted during the annual recruitment process. Pursuant to the Maddy Act, the recruitment for the unscheduled vacancy was posted on June 27, 2016 with the application filing period closing on July 8, 2016.

During the recruitment process for the scheduled vacancies, the City received eight applications. The two incumbents are recommended for reappointment, leaving six qualified applicants eligible for appointment to fill the unscheduled vacancy. During the recruitment process for the unscheduled vacancy, the City received one additional application.

After reviewing applications, the following appointment to the Investment Review Committee is recommended: Mark Kroenke (Attachment \#1).

Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:
On behalf of Many Mansions, a nonprofit affordable housing and service provider headquartered in Thousand Oaks, we give qualified support to the various proposed amendments to the Thousand Oaks Boulevard Specific Plan 20 ('Specific Plan 20') by the Thousand Oaks Boulevard Property Improvement District ('BID').

We believe that the proposed amendments will increase the development of much needed housing on the Boulevard and will restore the 'balance' of available housing in the community.

However, since the need for affordable housing is so great, the Council should also reinstate the Inclusionary Housing Program (TOMC §9-10.301) and require that $10 \%$ of all new housing units, for-sale and rental, be affordable to low and very-low income households.

Although we believe that the Inclusionary Housing Program should be reinstated city-wide, it certainly should be reinstated in Specific Plan 20. The Boulevard is an excellent location to develop affordable housing, especially for low-income seniors, and the proposed allocation of 206 additional housing units leaves relatively few housing units available for future affordable housing development under Measure E. The City and Council should also explore a variety of other measures that cities have adopted to increase the development of affordable housing.

## Thousand Oaks needs more affordable housing.

Many Mansions own waiting list for housing now exceeds 1,600 households. The Area Housing Authority's waiting list is even larger. Many households have a difficult time finding landlords willing to accept Section 8 vouchers.

Despite this need, very little affordable housing has been developed in the City since the dissolution of the Redevelopment Agency. Many Mansions' Hillcrest Villas Apartments (60 units) and the Area Housing Authority's Garden View Terrace ( 56 units) are the last affordable housing rental properties developed in the City and both projects had substantial funding from the Redevelopment Agency.

We appreciate all that the City Council has done to preserve the existing affordable housing stock in the face of budget cuts and reduced development opportunities. We believe, like the City Council does, that much more is possible.

Therefore, Many Mansions gives its qualified support for the proposed amendments to Specific Plan 20 since the amendments will create additional housing.

More housing, especially rental and condominium-type housing, is needed in the City. With the average price of single-family homes over $\$ 650,000$ and the average monthly rental prices for a two-bedroom apartment over $\$ 1,850$, there is very little affordable housing stock for a wide range of the City's residents and potential residents.

In short, there is an imbalance in the available housing stock. As is noted in the Staff Report, one important General Plan policy is to create a 'balance of living. . .facilities.' The present imbalance forces many residents to live in housing that could better serve the low-income population. For example, several recent Many Mansions' residents who were no longer 'low income' had to remain in Many Mansions' housing because there were no affordable alternatives. Creating more housing 'frees up' this housing stock and allows a balance to return to the community.

The City Council, however, should take additional steps to increase the development of affordable housing. The first step would be to reinstate the City's Inclusionary Housing Policy.

The City is missing an opportunity to increase affordable housing in the community by not requiring that a certain percentage of the new

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housing on the Boulevard be 'affordable.' By 'affordable' Many Mansions means dedicated housing units restricted to households who are 'low' ( $80 \%$ AMI) and 'very low' ( $50 \%$ AMI) income.

The City can accomplish this by simply reinstating its Inclusionary Housing Program (TOMC § 9-10.301, et. seq.). The Inclusionary Housing Program, adopted in 2008, required, among other things, that developers of 'for-sale' housing of more than 5 units provide that at least $10 \%$ of its housing units be restricted for sale to 'moderate' income households or pay a specified 'in-lieu fee'. This ordinance codified a long-standing policy by the City of requiring affordable housing units in new developments. The City suspended the program in 2010 after the economic downturn.

The timing is right to reinstate the Inclusionary Housing Program, especially as it applies to the Boulevard and Specific Plan 20.

Ideally, the Inclusionary Housing Program should be reinstated city-wide. The economy has picked up, housing development has picked up, and the need for affordable housing has only grown since the City Council adopted the Inclusionary Housing Program in 2008. Given the constraints in the development of affordable housing, the City needs to look more toward private developers to create additional affordable housing units.

In any regard, the Inclusionary Housing Program should be reinstated in Specific Plan 20. Housing on the Boulevard is ideal for affordable housing, especially senior affordable housing. Advantages for such affordable housing are-

1. The housing would be smaller and thus amenable to individuals and couples, especially seniors;
2. The housing would be near needed services, jobs, and shopping;
3. The housing could utilize the existing public transportation system and thus not need additional parking spaces; and
4. The housing could be less expensive to develop since its cost would be spread over the entire mixed-use development.

The City should strengthen the Inclusionary Housing Program through a few simply modifications. The inclusionary housing for

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'moderate' income should be replaced with 'low' and 'very low' income. Multifamily rental units should also be included.

Reinstating the Inclusionary Housing Program would not be burdensome. The proposed changes to Specific Plan 20 would only bring the number of allocated housing units to Specific Plan 20 to 495 housing units $(206+289)$. Even if the Program applies to all 495 housing units, this would generate at most 50 affordable units ( $10 \% \times 495$ ). Because of existing projects and projects under the 6 unit threshold, the number of affordable units would certainly be less.

The danger in not reinstating the Inclusionary Housing Program is that the City is committing a substantial number of its 'remaining Measure E housing units' to Specific Plan 20. The proposal commits 29\% (206/711) of the remaining Measure E housing units to Specific Plan 20. Since any new affordable housing project must be large and of increased density, there is a danger that no new affordable housing could or would be developed in the City.

The City should then look to other cities as to additional landuse policies that encourage affordable housing development.

Many Mansions suggests that the City study other cities' approaches to creating additional affordable housing in their communities. Some possible approaches include-

1. Allow a $100 \%$ density bonus for projects which are $100 \%$ affordable for seniors. The County of Ventura and the city of Moorpark have done this. Simi Valley recently gave a 71\% density bonus to a recently approved affordable housing project. The extra units created through a density bonus do not come under Measure E;
2. Authorize by-right approval for $100 \%$ affordable housing development by implementing "Affordable Home Overlay Zones" in local plans. The City of Oxnard did this with their AAHOP program which actually allows a $100 \%$ affordable housing projects in an AAHOP overlay to build 20 units/acre and streamlines project approval;
3. Waive the majority of development impact fees for $100 \%$ affordable developments for seniors or persons with disabilities. The City already does this for senior projects but the City could

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expand this to other special needs populations or affordable housing in general; and
4. Have zoning codes allow for multifamily development in commercial zones. The cities of Oxnard and Los Angeles allow this and this helps turn underutilized commercial sites into housing.
Many Mansions would be happy to assist the City in creating other incentives for the development of more affordable housing.

In summary, we support the proposal to amend Specific Plan 20.

The Thousand Oaks City Council fired City
Manager Scott Mitnick on Thursday night in a nearly six-hour closed meeting.
"The council voted unanimously to terminate the employment of (Mitnick) pursuant to the terms of his contract, effective immediately," Mayor Joel Price said as he and other council members emerged from Scott Mitnick behind closed doors shortly before midnight.

"We are heading in a different direction and remain focused on preparing our city for the future and continuing the great things we have accomplished," said Price, reading from a prepared statement. "The council and I have full confidence in the organization's solid leadership and management, along with highly dedicated staff to carry us forward in a productive way, especially during this period of transition."

Mitnick has been city manager since 2005.

He acknowledged last month that he had used his city email account to help secure donations from local businesses for his son's Westlake High School baseball team, and promised never to do it again.

Mitnick admitted that he had used his professional email account when helping Westlake High School Baseball Boosters obtain payment and other information from local shopping centers.

Mitnick also had placed on hold a $\$ 20,000$ grant to the boosters organization for field improvements. City Attorney Tracy Noonan said in June that after reviewing the grant, she informed the group that she advised the city to proceed with the grant.

Mitnick's role in the grant became the subject of a four-hour closed-door City Council meeting on May 16, at which the council took no disciplinary action against him.

He was not seen after Thursday night's meeting and was unavailable for comment.

Price said the council would decline to make any other statements on the termination, noting that it was a personnel matter.
