



THOUSAND OAKS BLVD UTILITY UNDERGROUNDING PROJECT

IMPROVEMENTS COMING TO THOUSAND OAKS BOULEVARD!

The City of Thousand Oaks is working with local utility companies to remove approximately 1.5 miles of overhead electrical wires and 48 electrical poles along Thousand Oaks Boulevard, from Duesenberg Drive to Westlake High School at Via Merida.

Construction is expected to begin in Winter 2016 and continue through Spring 2017. During that time, you may notice periodic lane closures and traffic congestion along Thousand Oaks Boulevard as the utility lines are relocated underground. Residents and businesses in the project area will be notified in advance of construction activity and closures.
