

Los Feliz Sidewalk Improvement Project



NEW SIDEWALKS ARE COMING TO LOS FELIZ DRIVE!

Background:

The City maintains a priority list that ranks missing sidewalk locations based on several factors, including pedestrian traffic volumes, proximity to schools, and road classifications. Los Feliz Sidewalk, Phase II location was identified as a top priority.

What to Expect:

The proposed improvements include installing approximately 800 feet of sidewalk on both sides of Los Feliz Drive, between Conejo School Road and Thousand Oaks Boulevard. The project also includes concrete curb and gutter, driveway reconstruction and replacing 1550 feet of water main. There is a need to acquire temporary and permanent easements to implement the project.

The City was awarded an Active Transportation Program (ATP) Grant in the amount of \$898,000 for the construction phase of the project in February 2019.

Project Benefits:

This project will increase safety for pedestrians and the vehicle traffic. Also, it will connect to existing school, shopping and commercial destinations increasing active transportation modes.

Schedule:

Preliminary Design: Fall 2019
R/W Acquisition: Winter 2019 to Spring 2020
Final Design: Summer 2020
Caltrans Approval: Fall 2020
Bid and Award Contract: Winter 2020
Construction: Spring 2021 to Spring 2022

Estimated Total Project Cost:

\$2.4 million including \$900k in Federal Grant Funds
