The Annual Water Quality Report (also known as a Consumer Confidence Report, or CCR), contains important information about your drinking water. The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requires the City of Thousand Oaks to provide you this report on a yearly basis.

The purpose of the Annual Water Quality Report is to raise customers' awareness of the quality of their drinking water, where their drinking water comes from, what it takes to deliver water to their homes, and the importance of protecting drinking water sources.

Historically, the City of Thousand Oaks has mailed its customers a printed copy of the Annual Water Quality Report. The State Water Resources Control Board now allows for electronic delivery of the Annual Water Quality Report.

Expired/Unwanted Medication Disposal

At home, remove pills and other solid medications from their containers and consolidate them into a clear, plastic, zippered bag. Drop off the bag of pills/solids and any liquids and creams tightly sealed in their original packaging at one of the drop-off locations below.
