DATES COVERED/ DEADLINES	REQUIRED FORMS AND GENERAL INFORMATION
May 3, 2020	First day to receive contributions or make expenditures (Six months prior to election.)
July 13 - August 7, 2020	Nomination Period Starts First day to receive and file Nomination Papers.
January 1 - June 30, 2020 Due: July 31, 2020, 5:00 p.m.	Form 460 - Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement Deliver to the City Clerk Department by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) and followed by personal delivery drop-off or first-class mail.
August 5 – November 3, 2020	Form 497 - 24 Hour Contribution Report file within 24 hours by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) ONLY, personal delivery drop-off ONLY, guaranteed overnight service ONLY, or fax ONLY; file if you gave a personal loan of \$1,000+ within 90 days before election. Reports due on a weekend or state holiday (<u>other than weekend before the election</u>) are extended to the next business day.
August 7, 2020	Nomination Period Ends All forms (with original wet signatures) must be filed concurrently in the City Clerk Department no later than 5:00 p.m.
August 8 – 17, 2020	Nomination Papers/Public Review Period Candidate Statements are available for public examination in the City Clerk Department and on the City's web site.
August 8 – August 12, 2020	Nomination Period Extended for 5 calendar days if <i>incumbent</i> does not file.
August 13, 2020	Random alphabet drawing for ballot order (Secretary of State) 11:00 a.m.
September 7 – October 20, 2020, 5:00 p.m.	Write-in Candidate period
September 19, 2020	First day temporary signs may be displayed (Not more than 45 days prior to election).
July 1– September 19, 2020 Due: September 24, 2020, 5:00 p.m.	Form 470 (2020 Calendar Year) or Form 460 - First Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement Deliver to the City Clerk Department by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) and followed by personal delivery drop-off or first-class mail.
September 24 – October 13, 2020	Voter Information Guide Mailing Between these dates Voter Information Guide will be mailed by County Elections Official.

DATE/ DEADLINE	FORMS REQUIRED AND GENERAL INFORMATION
October 5 – October 27, 2020	Vote by Mail Ballots Voters will receive vote by mail ballots from the County of Ventura during this period.
October 19, 2020	Last day to register to vote in November 3, 2020 General Election
October 20, 2020	Walk-In Voting First day citizens can provisionally register and/or walk in to County of Ventura Elections Division and vote in person
September 20 – October 17, 2020 Due: October 22, 2020, 5:00 p.m.	Form 460 - Second Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement Deliver to the City Clerk Department by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) and followed by personal delivery drop-off or first-class mail.
October 24 – November 3, 2020	Form 497 - 24 Hour Contribution Report file within 24 hours by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) ONLY, personal delivery drop-off ONLY, guaranteed overnight service ONLY, or fax ONLY; if you receive a contribution of \$100+.
October 18 – October 24, 2020 Due: October 27, 2020, 5:00 p.m.	Form 460 - Third Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement Deliver to the City Clerk Department by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) and followed by personal delivery drop-off or first-class mail.
November 3, 2020	ELECTION DAY
November 10, 2020	All temporary signs must be removed (No later than 7 days after Election.)
November 5 – December 3, 2020	OFFICIAL CANVASS
December 8, 2020	Oaths of Office will be administered by the City Clerk at the annual City Council Reorganization Meeting.
 UPDATED DATES: October 25 – December 31, 2020 Due: February 1, 2021, 5:00 p.m.	Form 460 - Semi-Annual Campaign Expenditure Statement Deliver to the City Clerk Department by email (cityclerk@toaks.org) and followed by personal delivery drop-off or first-class mail.
