### Large Item Pickup

Residents living in SFD and MFD-I complexes may request up to two free collections, including a total of six large items picked up per calendar year.

Large items (or “Bulky Waste”) are oversized or overweight household articles that do not fit in a regular trash cart such as appliances, furniture, tires, carpets, mattresses, and similar large items, and require special handling due to their size but can be collected and transported without the assistance of special loading equipment (such as forklifts or cranes). It does not include abandoned automobiles and other vehicles.

### Household Hazardous Waste Home Collection

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) home collection is available to residents living in SFD and MFD-I complexes free of charge up to four times per year.

Leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients are considered HHW, and include products such as cleaners, oils, paint, batteries, automotive fluids, fluorescent lights and pesticides that require special handling and should not be disposed in a regular trash container.

### \*Move-In/Move-Out Collection Service

Within three (3) months of opening a new account, at no additional charge, each customer may request one on-call Move-In/Out Recyclable Material Collection Service for recyclable packaging materials such as flattened cardboard boxes, and bundled newspaper and packaging foam. This will be offered as a one-time service for each new account. This service shall only include Recyclable Materials, and if the Service Recipient includes Garbage in the materials set out for Collection, the Garbage shall be counted as one of the free annual Large Item Collections. A Move In/Out request beyond the first three months will incur a fee stipulated in table above.

### \*\*Overage Fee

Overage fee applies if container is habitually overfilled. Resident has the option of upsizing or adding containers if they need additional capacity to avoid overfilling.
