Board Details

The purpose of the Conejo Open Space Conservation Agency (COSCA) is to develop a jurisdictional land management framework for the conservation of natural open space land areas; assure coordination of local land use and resource management decisions relating to open space and land areas; and function as an entity to focus community resources towards achievement of adopted general plan goals pertaining to open space and natural resources.

COSCA consists of 2 City Councilmembers, 2 CRPD Board members and one public member serving on the COSCA Board of Directors. The public member must be a resident within the City limits or the Conejo Recreation and Park District (CRPD) boundary. Conflict of Interest filing is required (VC Clerk of the Board is filing official).

The public member serves four years. The COSCA nominee is submitted to both the City Council and CRPD for mutual agreement of the appointment.
