Board Details

The Area Housing Authority of the County of Ventura (AHACV) is a Public Housing Authority representing seven jurisdictions, including the cities of Camarillo, Fillmore, Ojai, Moorpark, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, and the County of Ventura. AHACV serves as the City of Thousand Oaks' Housing Authority and represents each of its seven-member jurisdictions in that capacity. AHACV is governed by a Board of 15 Commissioners, two appointed from each of the seven local government jurisdictions and one "at-large" resident Commissioner appointed by AHACV and confirmed by seven local government jurisdictions. Agency Commissioners are appointed for four-year terms, and the resident Commissioner, by state law, serves a two-year term. On behalf of its member agencies, AHACV implements the Federal Section 8 Rental Subsidy Program for residents within its member jurisdictions and owns and manages public housing units within Ventura County.
