NOTICE OF PROPOSED WASTEWATER RATE ADJUSTMENTS

The City of Thousand Oaks is proposing to adjust the monthly wastewater rate, effective July 1, 2022 and July 1, 2023. The average residential City of Thousand Oaks wastewater customer, located inside City limits, will see an increase of \$0.90 (3.0%) per month, effective July 2022 and \$0.93 (3.0%) per month in July 2023. The proposed rates are based on the City’s 2022 Wastewater Financial Plan Update which determines the rate adjustments necessary to pay for wastewater service, including operating, maintenance and capital expenses. Complete information on current rates and the 2022 Financial Plan can be found on the City’s website www.toaks.org/UtilityRates. The table below shows the current and proposed rate adjustments per service unit (1 service unit = 1 single family residential unit = 1 equivalent residential unit).

Written protests on the proposed rate changes may be submitted during the public hearing (if Chambers are closed to the public at that time, submissions will be received directly outside of Chambers) or may be delivered any time before the hearing to the City Clerk, 2100 Thousand Oaks Blvd., Thousand Oaks, CA 91362.
